Phonics

- Practise reading and writing all the sounds in your child's pink Home Learning Book.
- Practise writing words which include the sounds.
- Read and write all previously learnt high frequency and tricky words.

<u>Writing</u>

- Grapheme/phoneme correspondence (writing down a sound)
- Use phonetic knowledge to write words which match their spoken sounds.
- Write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others.

Reading

- Enjoy reading together any books (fiction, non-fiction, poems, magazines)
- Bug Club Books

<u>Maths</u>

- Number formation 0-9
- Using number knowledge to write numbers 0-20
- State one more/one less than a number to 20
- Using quantities and objects, add and subtract U+U (7 + 3) and TU+U (12 + 7)
- Make and use a number line 0-20 to count on/back to find an answer
- Use everyday language to talk about size, weight, capacity, position, money.
- Create and describe patterns.
- Identify 2D/3D shapes in the environment. Name and describe them.

- Following 2/3 step instructions
- Fasten buttons/zips and tie shoe laces
- Know about and make choices in relation to healthy eating and exercise.
